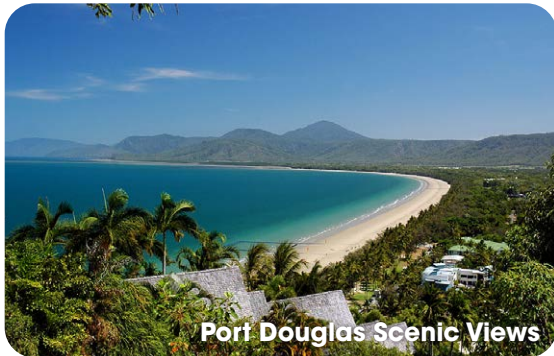


PORT DOUGLAS & MOSSMAN GORGE (TPMW)

7:45am Commence pickups from Cairns accommodation.

8:20am Depart Cairns. Travel to Port Douglas via the Captain Cook Highway, one of Australia's most scenic coastal drives.

9:40am Commence pickups from Port Douglas accommodation. Continue a guided sightseeing tour.

10:35am Arrive at Wildlife Habitat. Wander through the park's four environments, you can hand-feed kangaroos and wallabies, observe cassowaries, crocodiles and Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroos. Enjoy a wildlife presentation and a delicious lunch in a tropical setting.



12:35pm Depart Wildlife Habitat Port Douglas.

12:45pm Arrive at Mossman Gorge Visitor Centre.

1:00pm Experience Welcome to Country & Smoking Ceremony with Indigenous Guide.

1:15pm Board the shuttle bus to Mossman Gorge National Park.

1:25pm Join a guided walk in the Mossman Gorge National Park or explore the area and the various hiking tracks to suit your fitness level



3:00pm Shuttle back to the visitor centre or enjoy free time exploring or resting in the beautiful surroundings.

3:30pm Last shuttle back to Mossman Gorge Visitor Centre to meet your driver guide.



4:40pm Arrive at Port Douglas accommodation.

6:10pm Arrive at Cairns accommodation.

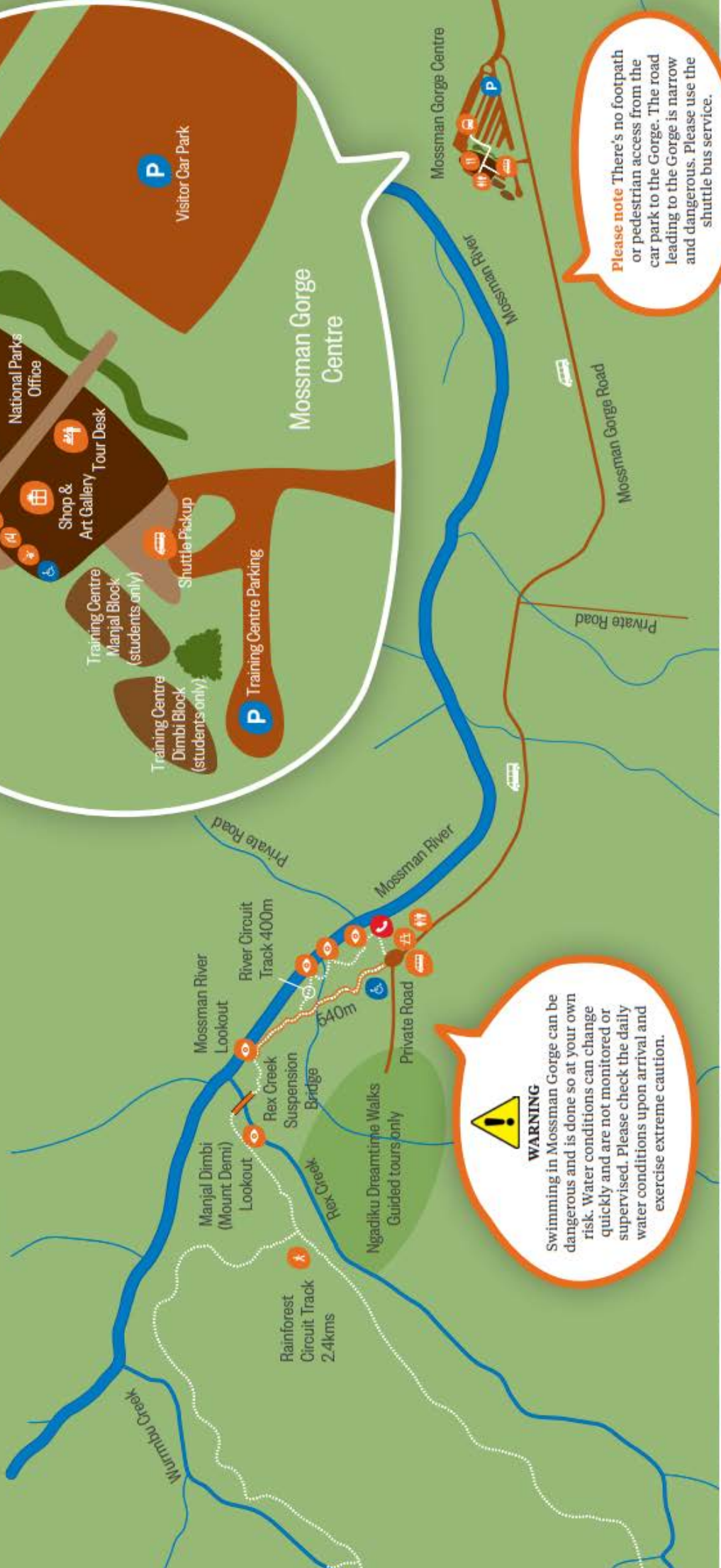
